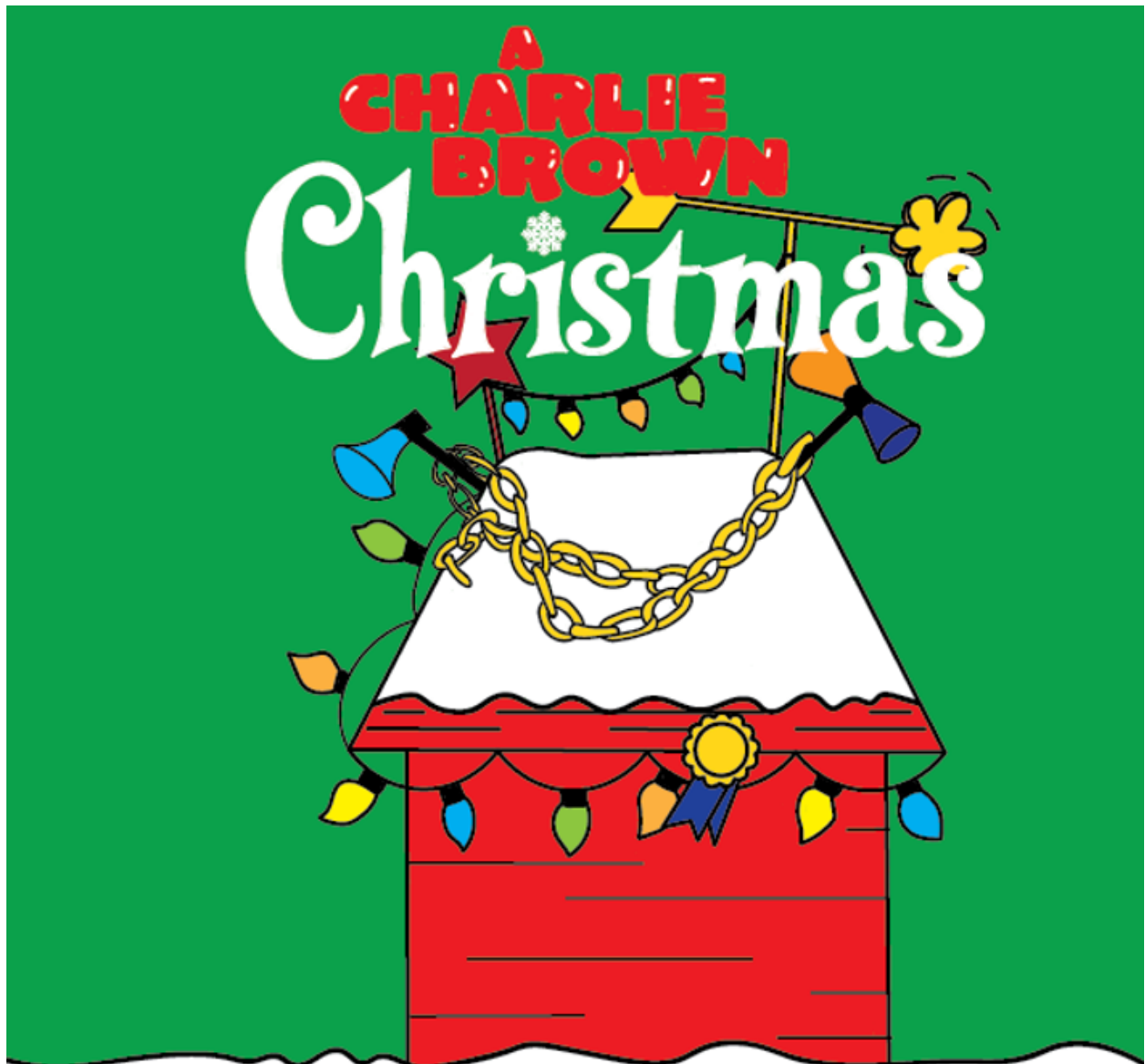


Sensory Friendly Performance: Production Timeline

On Thursday December 14th,

I am going to see a play called
“A Charlie Brown Christmas”

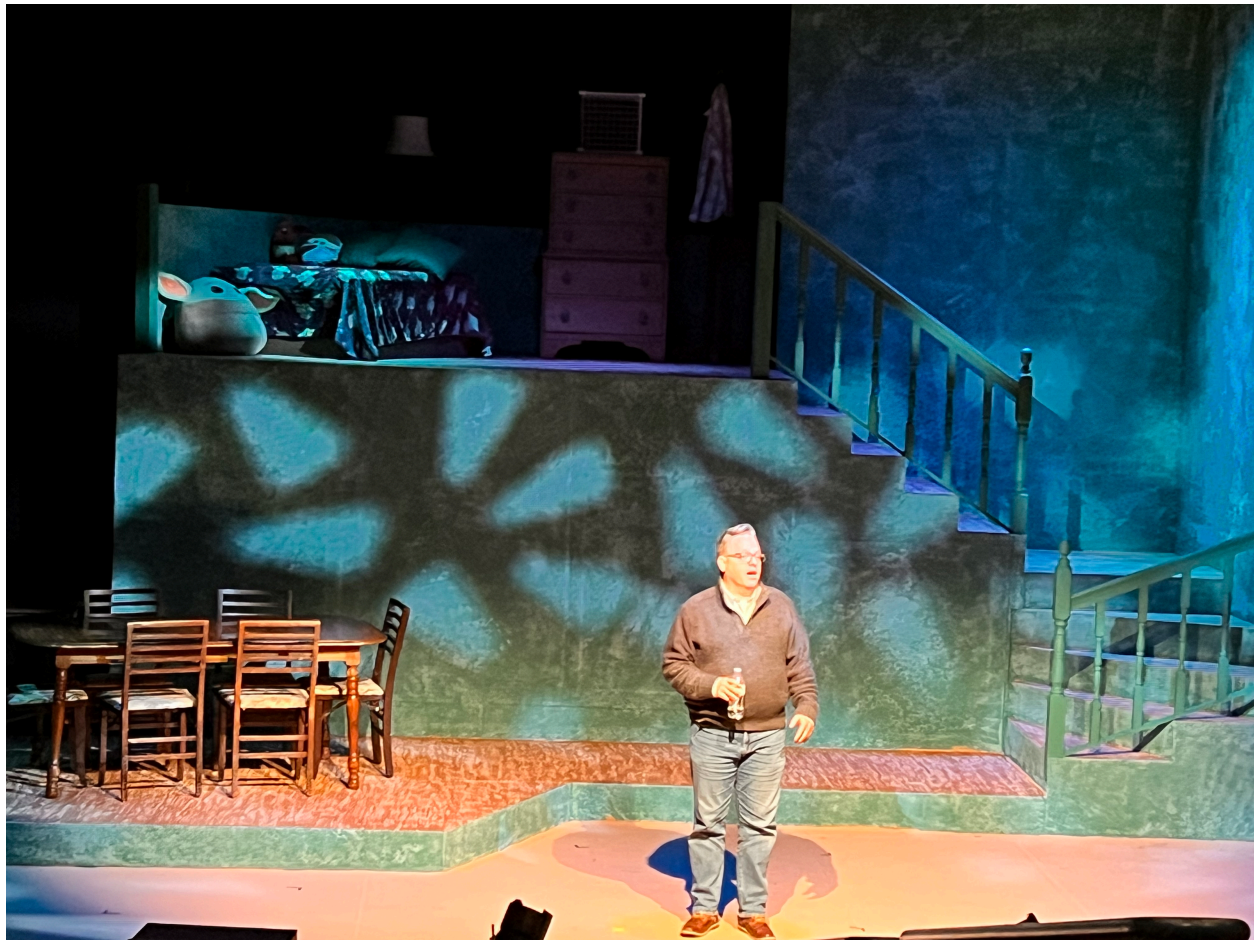
This is the story of three girls who are working on a Halloween project with a local haunted house.

Here is what I will see and hear during the play:

When I walk into the theatre, I will see lots of **seats**. I get to pick a seat to sit in. I can sit down front, in the middle, or in the back.



When it is time for the play to start, one of the Youtheatre **directors** will come out onstage to talk to the audience and give a **Preshow speech**. He tells me how happy he is that I am here. Everyone is happy I am here. At the end of his speech, we **clap**.

I see Charlie Brown go to Lucy's psychiatrist booth. He tells her he feels sad. She tries to help him feel better by suggesting that he direct the Christmas play.



I see **Charlie Brown** help his sister, **Sally Brown**, write a letter to Santa.

I see all of the **Peanuts** gang as they write their letters to Santa Claus.



I see the Peanuts characters as they get ready for the Christmas Play.

I see Charlie Brown arrive to the Christmas play rehearsal. I remember this scene from the filmed show!

The rehearsal is disorganized. Nothing goes according to plan. Charlie Brown gets tasked with going to find a Christmas Tree for the play.



I see Charlie Brown and Linus as they pick out their tree. They pick a very small, sad looking tree.

I see Linus as he shows Lucy the music he has picked for the Christmas play.



I see the **Peanuts** characters talk about how nobody likes the tree that **Charlie Brown** picked out.

I see Linus, as he tells the true meaning of Christmas. Christmas isn't about the tree, or the play... Christmas is about the Christmas story. Linus recites the scripture's about Christ's birth.



I see Snoopy get awarded 1st Prize for his doghouse decorations.

I see Linus compliment Charlie's tree, as Charlie decorates it with an ornament.

I see everyone wish Charlie Brown a Merry Christmas. The cast of the show sings again.
